## Second annual Pulse Survey

- Designed to take "the pulse" of our membership
- Captures member feedback and interests
- Compare results to inaugural 2023 Pulse Survey






## Results as of March 15, 2024

- 37 respondents (2023: 30)
- Shortest time to complete: 4 minutes (2023: 3 minutes)
- Longest time to complete: 49 minutes (2023: 30 minutes)







### **Other take-aways**

- More members are open to attending both in-person and virtual events
- More members attended social pop-up events
- Significantly fewer members reported hosting a guest in 2023, but more members are likely to host a guest in 2024




## Did you attend any monthly meetings in 2023?

[2023: 96.7%]






## Did you attend a social pop-up in 2023?



86.5% of respondents attended a social pop-up, an increase of nearly 8%




## Did you host a guest in 2023?



Only 2 respondents said they hosted a guest in 2023. This is 50% fewer than last year.

- 8 members (21.6%) said they're somewhat likely to host a guest
- 15 members (40.5%) said they're somewhat unlikely or unlikely to host a guest








### What event format would you consider attending in 2024?

- 86.5% of respondents would consider attending both in-person and virtual (Zoom) events
  - [2023: 74.1%]
- 3 respondents (8%) would consider attending only virtual (Zoom) events
  - [2023: 22.2%]
- 2 respondents (5%) would consider attending only in-person events
  - [2023: 3.7%]




## How useful do you find the TMD website?

- 11 respondents (29.7%) found the website very useful
  - 2023: 27.6%
- 2 respondents (5.41%) found the website not very useful
  - 2023: 0%
- 6 respondents (16.2%) didn't answer the question
  - 2023: 20.7%






## Why did you visit the TMD website in 2022?

- The most common reasons a member visited the website were to register/RSVP or to see the event calendar (59%)
  - 2023: 67.8%
- 30 members (25.6%) Look for member directory
  - 2023: 19.4%






Multiple choices were allowed

- Looked for event and Board member history. Also looked at the list of recommended books.
- Look for Member Contact List
- The site is great for transactions and data...less helpful on more general info about TMD.
- I visited often to review the write up for our Financial popup

### If you used the online registration process, how would you rate it?

- Most respondents (72.9%) of respondents rated the online registration process as very satisfactory or satisfactory
  - 2023: 65.5%
- 10.8% of respondents rated it as less than satisfactory
  - 2023: 17.2%


- Again....I'm learning how to use it. It is not always obvious; for example, that one needs to click on the event under "Upcoming Events" in order to register for it.

### If you used the RSVP function, how would you rate it?

- Most members (62.1%) rated the RSVP function highly (Very satisfactory, Satisfactory)
  - 2023: 56.6%







- Loved the addition of the guest's name and email address.
- I like seeing who else is coming. I also see right away whether I've registered or not.
- I haven't used it yet




### How often do you visit the TMD Facebook page?

- 17 respondents (47.2%) said they visit infrequently
  - 2023: 35.4%
- 6 respondents (16.7%) said they visit rarely
  - 2023: 30.4%
- None of respondents said they visit daily
  - 2023: 5%

#### Comments

- I wish more people used it but I look at it regularly and post pictures when I have them.
- I forget it's there
- I don't use FB---too easy to go down the rabbit hole and waste time. I would prefer a "push" to members of things that are important.
- I don't do Facebook anymore. I'll go up to see something if someone tells me to go look, but I try to avoid getting sucked in. I like seeing the photos when I do visit.
- I don't visit it specifically but sometimes it shows up in my feed

- I have been off FB for a few years now. I check in every once in a while (long while ;-) so it is not that I do not visit the TMD page, I just do not visit FB!









### Did you volunteer for a committee or serve on the board in 2023?


- A majority (78.4%) of respondents (29) reported serving as a volunteer or board member

- I hope to host a social pop up in Capitola when the rainy weather is pretty much done for the spring.








#### Are you familiar/experienced with any of the following?



- Women Build, part of Habitat for Humanity. Good Work Foundation. Dance community in Portland. I run my own business



#### TMD members are active and have varied interests




## How satisfied are you with your TMD membership?

- The majority (78.3%) of respondents (29) are very satisfied (48.6%) or satisfied (29.7%)
  - 2023: 20 very satisfied (43.3%) or satisfied (23.3%)
- 5 (13.5%) are neutral (neither satisfied or dissatisfied)
  - 2023: 7 (23.3%)
- 3 respondents are dissatisfied (2) or very dissatisfied (1)
  - 2023: 2 dissatisfied 5.41%, 1 very dissatisfied 2.7%













# How satisfied are you with your TMD membership?

- Very grateful for my TMD Sisters
- I miss being there in person. Not quite the same from a distance.
- I seldom attend anything on zoom
- It seems like there's been a significant shift in TMD. It used to be about the monthly meetings and twice-yearly socials. Now it seems like there is so much focus on pop-ups. I also feel like there is pressure to attend/participate in pop-ups to make them succeed. # What else would you like to share with us about TMD?


- I realized how much this tribe means to me when we came to the brink of losing it.

- Highly value membership in TMD!




### What's your age range?



The majority (62.2%) of respondents (29) are aged 60 – 69 years








#### What's your employment status?
